Title: *You CAN Teach An Old Dog New Tricks: 12 Leads With a 3 Lead Monitor*

Brief Description:

Want to do 12-leads, but can't convince your service to retire the old Lifepak-5? Would you recognize an infarct if you saw one, and more importantly, would you understand its significance? In this presentation, we will discuss how to utilize MCL leads in infarct recognition as we teach your old dog of a Lifepak-5 some new tricks.

Objectives:

1. Recognize the value of the prehospital 12-lead EKG in reducing the "door-to-drug time."
2. Understand the basic principles of infarct recognition and localization using 12-lead criteria.
3. Understand how to apply 12-lead criteria using MCL leads in a 3 lead monitor.
4. Differentiate true infarcts from impostors.
5. Recognize the clinical significance of various infarct locations.
